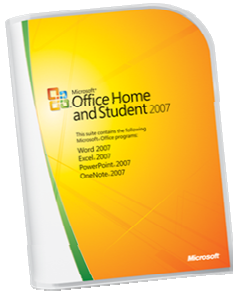

MyInfospace is a Windows PC Application that provides you a secure place to organise and sort your personal information (things like your education details, your employment history, key documents, user IDs). You can also create a simple Income and Expenditure and Net Worth statement to understand your financial situation. You can also store information about your personal assets to ensure you have the information you need to manage them well. There is also a section to record your thoughts and memories in a simple digital diary. This will help you keep a track of important information you want to remember in years to come.
